

7. Nominating Committee

- A. The mission of the Nominating Committee is to solicit, interview and recommend to the ACOFP Congress of Delegates qualified candidates for the positions of President-elect, Vice President, Secretary/Treasurer, Governor, Resident Governor, Student Governor, Speaker, and Vice Speaker.

Composition

- 1) Shall be composed of a maximum of seven immediate past presidents or as appointment by the President as a replacement.
- 2) The ACOFP Past President shall be the Nominating Committee Chair, and the Immediate Past President shall serve as the Nominating Committee Vice Chair.
- 3) The Past Presidents shall be members of the committee in sequence until they have served on the Committee for a maximum of seven years.
- 4) In the case of resignation or death of a Nominating Committee member, the President will appoint a replacement from the pool of Past Presidents to fill that unexpired term.

B. Nominating Process

- 1) The Nominating Committee shall submit to the President and the Board of Governors at least 30 days prior to the first session of the ACOFP Congress of Delegates a list of the nominees for the various offices. The list shall contain not less than one or more than two nominees for each office. This list shall be published in the Congress of Delegates manual.
- 2) ACOFP Affiliate State Societies will be invited to submit written nominations for ACOFP elected positions, by the Chair of the Nominating Committee prior to the meeting of the Nominating Committee. If states wish to submit more than one nominee for a position, they will be asked to rank-order their nominees.
