The Committee encourages the diverse involvement of Students, Residents and Practicing Physicians.

POSTER JUDGING CRITERIA

The Committee will award ten (10) points for each category listed below (*Maximum Score: 40*):

INTRODUCTION

- Uniqueness
- Unusual diagnosis or clinical course.
- Contribution to scientific knowledge.
- Describes the instructive or teaching points that add value to this case.

CASE SUMMARY

- Describes the presenting signs and symptoms and clinical course.
- Cause of patient's illness was clearly presented. Other plausible explanations were discussed.
- Investigations to determine the diagnosis were discussed.
- Describes the treatment(s) provided and the rationale.
- Other therapeutic options were considered. Outcomes were related to treatments.

DISCUSSION

- Reports on literature review of other similar cases.
- Explains the rationale for reporting the case.
- Discusses how things could be done differently in a similar case.
- Discusses educational pearls.

ORAL PRESENTATION

- Presenter was organized and presented clearly.
- Relevance for the osteopathic family physician.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR POSTER SETUP

The Poster boards provided measure *4 feet by 6 feet* and are oriented horizontally in a landscape format. It is expected that poster materials will be of size and type to fit within the allotted space. The researcher is invited to bring a handout for the audience as well. The Committee must approve the use of any additional materials or equipment in advance. A limited amount of pushpins will be available at the convention. Participants are advised to bring their own supplies.
