The New Osteopathic Family Physician of the Year Award honors physicians who have made significant contributions to family medicine between two and five years after entering the specialty and demonstrated exemplary leadership qualities that would honor the memory of *Michael F. Avallone, DO, FACOFP dist.*, after whom the award is named.

Young Osteopathic Family Physician of the Year Award qualifications are:

- Must be an active ACOFP member in good standing.
- Must be in active practice in Osteopathic family medicine for between two and five years.
- Be certified by the American Osteopathic Association (AOA) or the American Board of Medical Specialists (ABMS).
- Service at the national or state level in any leadership capacity.

The New Osteopathic Family Physician of the Year Award requirements include:

- Completed application with their current curriculum vitae.
- At least one letter of support from the nominator and/or state affiliate society.
- Headshot photo which is suitable for publication.

Nominations are solicited from ACOFP affiliate state societies and the general membership, with the selection made by the ACOFP New Physician Committee, ACOFP Awards Committee and final approval by the ACOFP Board of Governors. The Award will be presented during the 2021 ACOFP Annual Convention and Scientific Seminars.
