

ACOFP Student Chapter Video Contest

The ACOFP Education & Research Foundation is holding a video contest for the ACOFP student chapters. Every chapter will be given the opportunity to submit a short video on how their chapter conducts projects that support the mission of the Foundation.

The mission of the ACOFP Education & Research Foundation is to encourage understanding of the principles and practices of osteopathic family medicine, promote osteopathic family physician leadership and to improve public health. The videos can highlight projects such as leadership roles at the chapters, disaster relief, and way they promote advancing healthcare.

Each chapter will receive \$250 for their submission. The Foundation's Board of Directors will review all submissions and select the top three. First place will receive \$1,500, second place will receive \$1,000 and third place will receive \$500. The first place video will be showed at the [ACOFP Annual Convention & Scientific Seminars](#).

Contest Submission Rules & Guidelines:

Eligibility: Each ACOFP student chapter may submit one video. Chapters which include more than one campus may submit one video per campus.

1. All entries must be a digital video and submitted in a digital format.
2. Each entry should demonstrate how your ACOFP student chapter works to fulfill the mission and vision of the ACOFP Education & Research Foundation.
3. The length of the video should be 3 - 5 min, not including the 10 second title screen (see #4 below).
4. All entries should begin with a 10 second full-screen "title screen" that includes the following information:
 - a. Lead Producer's name
 - b. School name
 - c. School city, state
 - d. Title of video
 - e. Total running time (not including the 10 second title screen)

5. All non-original information presented in the video must be cited, giving credit to the original source. Plagiarism of any kind will result in disqualification. You must submit a list of your sources, properly cited.
6. Each video must have one Lead Producer to serve as the main point of contact.
7. There is no entry fee.
8. Entries must be submitted by the assigned deadline . Winners will be announced at the [ACOFP Annual Convention & Scientific Seminars](#).
9. No copyrighted materials (music, images, etc.) may be used for this contest unless you own the copyright or have a license to use the material for this contest. Written proof of copyright ownership or permission must be provided at the time of submission
10. No professional assistance is allowed.
11. All portions of the online entry form must be completed when you upload your video for it to be eligible.
12. Content must comply with all local and national laws of the United States.
13. Video content must NOT include material which:
 - a. is (or promotes activities which are) sexually explicit, obscene, pornographic, violent, self-mutilating (e.g., relating to murder, the sales of weapons, cruelty, abuse, etc.), discriminatory (based on race, sex, religion, natural origin, physical disability, sexual orientation or age), illegal (e.g. underage drinking, substance abuse, computer hacking, etc.), offensive, threatening, profane, or harassing;
 - b. Include mention or performance of any copyrighted media production including but not limited to music, films, books, television programming, etc., or identifying descriptions of any media property.
 - c. Contain material that violates or infringes another's rights, including but not limited to material that violates privacy, publicity or intellectual property rights, or that constitutes copyright infringement. Without limiting the foregoing, Video Submissions must not include third party trademarks, logos, insignia, location signage, photographs, artwork, or sculptures. Use music that isn't originally written, performed and produced by you, the Entrant. We're not saying this because we don't love music; we do we really do! It's because we don't want to violate the copyright of musicians and artists. All music featured in any video must be available to publicize and broadcast on a license-free, no compensation basis.
 - d. Include third parties, including but not limited to minors, celebrities and friends who have not expressly authorized Entrants to display their image, likeness or voice in any submitted video or otherwise use such image, likeness or voice in accordance with these Official Rules.

14. The judges' decision is final. Entries will be judged by:
 - a. The degree to which the video demonstrates the mission and vision of the Foundation
 - b. Originality and creativity
 - c. Effectiveness and clarity of communication
15. The only compensation for submitting a video is the opportunity to be awarded a prize as indicated below in 17.
16. Awards will be presented as follows:
 - a. Every chapter who submits a video will receive \$250
 - b. Winning videos will receive an additional prize as follows
 - i. First prize \$1,500
 - ii. Second Prize \$1,000
 - iii. Third Prize \$500
17. Chapters should keep at least one copy of their video. ACOFP Foundation is not responsible for any submissions that are lost, damaged, or that do not upload properly.
18. Ownership of the underlying intellectual property of the project remains with the entrant, with the following exceptions:
 - a. Entrants grant ACOFP Foundation the right to use their names, photographs, statements, quotes, testimonials, and video submissions for advertising, publicity, and promotional purposes without notification or further compensation.
 - b. Entrants also grant ACOFP Foundation the unlimited right to use, reproduce, reprint, distribute, perform, and/or display the entrant's project video without further compensation or notification to the entrant.
 - c. ACOFP Foundation maintains the unlimited right to reproduce, reprint, distribute, perform, display, or exhibit the project for advertising, publicity, and promotional purposes on their website, at conferences, or at any other venues.
19. By accepting the prizes, winners agree to hold ACOFP Foundation and all ACOFP Foundation employees, agents, and contractors harmless against any and all claims and liability arising out of use of such prizes. Winner assumes all liability for any injury or damage caused from participation in the contest or use/redemption of any prize.
20. Entrants agree to be bound by the official contest rules and decisions of the judges.
