15 Congress to consider, and

17 WHEREAS, this paucity of resolutions fails to advance the profession or the mission and
18 goals of the ACOFP; now, therefore be it

20 RESOLVED, that the Congress of Delegates of the American College of Osteopathic Family
21 Physicians (ACOFP) encourages each ACOFP committee to submit at least one
22 resolution to the 2017 Congress of Delegates; and be it further

24 RESOLVED, that each ACOFP Affiliate State Society and Student Chapter is encouraged to
25 submit at least one resolution to the 2017 ACOFP Congress of Delegates.
