SUBJECT: Proposed amendments to the ACOFP Bylaws regarding the Nominating Committee Name Change to Leadership Development Committee **ACOFP Board of Governors** SUBMITTED BY: 2022 American College of Osteopathic Family Physicians (ACOFP) Congress REFERRED TO: of Delegates **RESOLUTION NO. 22** WHEREAS, the American College of Osteopathic Family Physicians (ACOFP) Board of Governors is committed to supporting and fostering a robust leadership pipeline to help govern the College now and for decades to come; and WHEREAS, the Board of Governors self-assessments in 2020 and 2021 identified Board composition as the assessment factor rated with the greatest opportunity for improvement; and WHEREAS, the April 2020 Governance and March 2021 Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) surveys illustrate member confusion on ACOFP's leadership pathways and opportunities as currently organized; and WHEREAS, the Board of Governors voted in October 2021 to change the Nominating Committee name to the Leadership Development Committee, in alignment with current leading practices for associations; and WHEREAS, the Board of Governors has prioritized the need to identify and support leadership development all year long, which concludes with the construct of a non-competitive appointment slate of ACOFP Board of Governors and Officers that meet objective competencies and are representative of the demographic elements of our membership; now, therefore be it RESOLVED, that the American College of Osteopathic Family Physicians (ACOFP) bylaws be amended, as follows, to change all references of the name Nominating Committee to the Leadership Development Committee to reflect the priority and efforts of the Board to support the identification and development of current and future leaders all year long. (Old material crossed out, new material added in color) **ARTICLE IX - ELECTIONS Section 1.** General B. The **Nominating Leadership Development** Committee shall submit a panel of nominees for the various positions to the President at least 30 days prior to the annual meeting.
