1 RESOLVED, that the American College of Osteopathic Family Physicians (ACOFP) Board of
2 Governors recommends the revised definition for Article III – Membership, Section 3: Active
3 Members in Good Standing in the ACOFP Constitution and Bylaws; and

6 Article III – Membership/ Section 3. Members in Good Standing

7 The term “in good standing” refers to active members who meet the following criteria: their dues
8 and assessments are current; they have no current restrictions on any medical licenses at the time
9 of application, and document CME hours consistent with the American Osteopathic Board of
10 Family Physicians (AOBFP) or American Board of Family Medicine (ABFM) requirements; and
11 they are in compliance with the ACOFP Code of Ethics. National officers, affiliate officers, and
12 residency program directors must be members in good standing.
