- 1 RESOLVED, that the American College of Osteopathic Family Physicians (ACOFP) Board of
- 2 Governors recommends the revised definition for Article III Membership, Section 3: Active
- 3 Members in Good Standing in the ACOFP Constitution and Bylaws; and
- 4 (Old material crossed out, new material in bold) 5
- 6 Article III Membership/ Section 3. Members in Good Standing
- 7 The term "in good standing" refers to active members who meet the following criteria: their dues
- 8 and assessments are current; they have no current restrictions on any medical licenses at the time
- 9 of application, and document CME hours consistent with the American Osteopathic Board of
- 10 Family Physicians (AOBFP) or American Board of Family Medicine (ABFM) requirements; and
- they are in compliance with the ACOFP Code of Ethics. National officers, affiliate officers, and
- residency program directors must be members in good standing.
